Elisea Frishberg declares under penalties of perjury pursuant to federal law that the facts set forth in this statement are true.

As an employee of Barrington Financial my functions were:

1. I attended investment meetings beginning in November 2010, when I obtained my Series 65 License. Prior to that I was charged with studying for and passing the Investment Advisor Exam.
2. I developed and executed the College Consultants program, as instructed by the CEO, which included dealing with the proprietor of the College Consultants Program, learning the content of the program and all presentations so that I could teach them to the other employees. I also met with prospective consultees on behalf of Barrington, and registered several of them in this program.
3. I produced, on behalf of Barrington, the radio program used by Barrington to market itself, including preparing the CEO for his appearances, contacting and inviting celebrity guests, and instructing the technical director on each day's show.
4. I was responsible to make certain that the advertising was timed and aired correctly.
5. I directed and planned monthly seminars, occasionally twice monthly, including planning the content, inviting prospects, coordinating with the Barrington sales people.
6. I produced the Moneygame, a weekend long seminar for Barrington prospective clients in Houston.
7. Barrington was paid by the Receiver of Bizradio to fulfill the obligations to the FCC which were the responsibility of the receiver to provide in-house management, when Salem Broadcasting took over management as temporary Lessee, for which Barrington billed the Receiver.
8. After becoming licensed, passing the Series 65 Exam for Investment Advisors, I was part of the investment committee, and collaborated with the sales department employees on events, educational projects and marketing.
9. Planned and put on 3 weekend seminars in Miami and eventually moved to Miami, charged by Barrington CEO with setting up a new Barrington office in Miami. I established contacts and was progressing with this job, when Barrington suddenly terminated my employment in October of 2011.
