ORDER TO STAY AND ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSE


The Court has entered Final Judgment against Defendants Laffer Frishberg Wallace Economic Opportunity Fund, L.P. [Doc. # 23] and Costa Bajjali [Doc. # 26]. The remaining Defendants West Houston WB Realty Fund, L.P. (“West Houston Fund”) and David G. Wallace (“Wallace”) have filed for bankruptcy protection in the Southern District of Texas, Houston Division, in Bankruptcy Case Nos. 4:15-bk-31773 and 15-31594-H4-7, respectively. Due to the Bankruptcy Code automatic stay, 11 U.S.C. § 362, no relief against West Houston Fund or Wallace may be granted at this stage. Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that this case is **STAYED** and **ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSED** pending resolution of Defendants West Houston Fund and Wallace’s bankruptcy proceedings or other orders permitting this matter to proceed against the

bankrupt Defendants. It is further

ORDERED that the Plaintiff and Court-Appointed Receiver Thomas L. Taylor, III shall file a written status report on **June 1, 2015**, and every six (6) months thereafter until this civil case is either dismissed or reinstated.
